\*\*\*\*\* **NOTICE TO PARENT / LEGAL GUARDIAN** \*\*\*\*\*

Although Explorer Post #106 Cadets are instructed in law enforcement principles, procedures, and tactics and do periodically assist with law enforcement community service activities, they are closely supervised by the Post Advisor(s) or other law enforcement officers during training events, competitions, and most community service events. (Some community service activities, like fingerprinting small children for their parents ("KidPrint"), do not require direct supervision of Explorer Cadets.) Prior to any training, Explorer competitions, or other activity that may pose a risk to the safety and security of your child, you will be notified and given an opportunity to approve or disapprove your child's participation in the activity.

If your child is seventeen years of age or younger, you are legally responsible for your child's Explorer uniform and other Explorer equipment.
